

ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS
TOWN OF HARWICH

Sealed Bids for the Allen Harbor Dredging Project for the Town of Harwich, Massachusetts will be received at the Office of the Town Administrator, Harwich Town Hall, 732 Main Street, Harwich, MA 02645 until 2:00 p.m. prevailing time on Wednesday, April 13, 2011 at 2:00 p.m. said bids will be publicly opened and read aloud.

A pre-bid meeting will be held at the Allen Harbor Parking Lot, located at 335 Lower County Road in Harwich on Wednesday, March 30, 2011 at 10:00 a.m.

The scope of work under this contract consists of provisions of all necessary labor, materials and equipment to hydraulically dredge Allen Harbor and mechanical de-water the dredged material to the specified consistency for removal and disposal by the Town of Harwich as shown in the plans and specifications. The project does not include disposal of de-watered dredge material which will be performed separately by the Harwich Department of Public Works (DPW). All materials and equipment of the Contractor, as may from time to time be left on the site, shall be at his own risk and the Town shall not be responsible for any damage or theft incurred.

The Contractor shall at all times prosecute the work in an orderly manner keeping his activities and storage of materials and equipment sufficiently neat and confined to avoid disruption of Public activities at Allen Harbor. The Engineer shall judge the propriety of a Contractor's conduct and may enforce on-site provisions which are considered in the best interest of the Town.

Bid security in the form of a bid bond, certified check, treasurer's or cashier's check, payable to the Town of Harwich, is required in a dollar amount of five (5) percent of the bid amount.

Contract Documents will be available after 9:00 A.M. on Thursday, March 17th, 2011 at the office of Coastal Engineering Company, Inc. Copies of the Contract Documents may be obtained free of charge from the office of Coastal Engineering Co., Inc., 260 Cranberry Highway, Orleans, MA 02653 between the hours of 8:30 A.M. to 4:30 P.M. Monday through Friday. Additional sets may be obtained for a non-refundable charge of \$25.00 made payable to Coastal Engineering Co., Inc. Contract Documents will be mailed to prospective bidders upon request and receipt of a separate check in the amount of \$25.00, made payable to Coastal Engineering Co., Inc., to cover handling and mailing fees.

All bids for this project are subject to applicable bidding laws of Massachusetts, including General Laws Chapter 149 and Chapter 30, Section 39M as amended. All bidders are required to be Massachusetts Division of Capital Asset Management (DCAM) Certified. Wage rates are subject to the minimum wage rates as per M.G.L. Chapter 149, Section 26 to 270 inclusive.

The Successful Bidder must furnish a 100% Performance Bond and 100% Payment Bond with a surety company acceptable to the Owner. Complete instructions for filing Bids are included in the Instructions to Bidders.

The Bidder agrees that this bid shall be good and may not be withdrawn for a period of 30 days, Saturdays, Sundays and legal Holidays excluded, after the opening of the bids. The Owner reserves the right to waive any informalities or to reject any or all bids
